I hope this letter finds you and your family safe and healthy. As you are aware, these are uncertain times that planning for re-opening of schools is challenging considering the unknowns when school is scheduled to start in August.


Here are updates since school closed to ensure you are informed as follows:

- Our Grab & Go lunches concluded on May 21<sup>st</sup> when our critical employees went on their summer break. The school provided hot lunches to community students under 18 years of age. Our lunch count ranged from 360 to the highest 391.
- BIE Central Office and Navajo District has established a Task Force to create procedures/guidelines for re-opening of schools. The Task Force is seeking input from school leaders alongside CDC guidelines. The task completion is expected at the end of June. Based on those procedures/guidelines, schools will plan the implementation process. This is all contingent upon our current pandemic situation if school will continue continuity of learning and/or other safety measures/structures will be implemented. Parents/guardians will be informed via letter what re-opening of our school will look like.
- BIE Task Force will also add to our existing enrollment packet information necessary for parents and students regarding COVID-19. Enrollment packets are readily available at this time without the addendum. You may choose to wait until the COVID-19 information becomes available to complete the enrollment packet. Some enrollment packets have been returned at this time, please be aware additional information on COVID -19 will be forthcoming when it becomes available.
- Report cards will be mailed by Tuesday, June 16<sup>th</sup>. Please check your mailbox after Tuesday next week.
- Our residential/academic facilities were sanitized last month, however, classrooms/offices are being clean by our school janitors. Cleaning of facility is paramount that we need to do all that is possible to keep our building safe and clean hoping for student/staff occupancy in August 2020.
- School office is open Monday-Friday with limited office staff, but still closed to the public. Any school/student related matters, please call for guidance/assistance at (505) 786-6160.

Lastly, I want to thank you for your support during our Grab n Go. Our critical employees who manned Grab n Go received homemade masks (assorted colors and designs) from several families as well as treats along with grateful messages via email.
